

## Modern Slavery Policy

Dellner Polymer Solutions is committed to ensuring all associated business processes and interactions does not involve acts of modern-day slavery and human trafficking. This applies to all supply chain activities, including sub-contractors and partners.

We acknowledge responsibility to the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and we will ensure transparency within the organisation and our suppliers of goods and services.

To ensure this statement is acted upon it will form part of our supplier approval process of ensuring all our supply chain also commit to ensuring they comply to the Modern Slavery Act 2015 which will be reviewed at regular intervals.

We also understand that goods imported from outside the UK and EU are potentially more at risk for being involved in slavery and human trafficking issues. Due to this the level of management controls required for those sources will be continually monitored and reviewed, as well as further actions when initially approving new suppliers from these areas.

We will not knowingly support or deal with any business involved in slavery or human trafficking.

The overall responsibility for ensuring our commitment to this policy is acknowledged and implemented from the top-level CEO to our Senior Management team.  
As part of ensuring this commitment is implemented, adequate resources will be provided through training, processes etc.

Policies and processes associated with this commitment will be incorporated into our Business System Manual which forms part of our requirements to ISO9001:2015.

We will ensure that this policy is communicated and understood to all levels of the company, and that it is regularly reviewed to ensure its relevance to the company activities.
